Thomas Ried, M.D.



Senior Investigator
Genetics Branch

Head, Cancer Genomics Section

Dr. Ried pioneered the development of molecular cytogenetic techniques, including spectral karyotyping (SKY) and their applications to understanding the dynamics of genomic alterations during the development of solid tumors, with an emphasis on breast, cervical and colorectal carcinomas.

His efforts include the development of relevant experimental models to study the effects of genomic instability and chromosomal aneuploidy on the transcriptional equilibrium of cancer cells, and to correlate such aberration to the organization of the cell nucleus. A specific goal is to understand how tumor heterogeneity influences disease progression. Dr. Ried's laboratory also has a strong commitment to translate their basic research findings to improve early cancer detection, prognostication, and treatment.

- 4) colorectal cancer, 5) gene expression

- Thomas Jefferson 7 classes plus activity period
- Bronx Science 5 classes plus additional courses

Academic Ground Rules


- All announced assessments should be posted on Schoology

College Admissions Trends

2020 Early-Round Admission Results Very Strong

At 19* of the most selective colleges that have early-accept programs (*US News* Top 20), for the Class of 2020 compared to Class of 2019

- 10 schools saw an increase in BCA admits
- **5** schools saw no change
- 4 schools saw a decrease

UCLA does not have early admissions

Areas of Opportunity

BCA Students are *still* currently *under-applying* to:

- 1) Top liberal arts colleges (i.e. Amherst, Williams, Swarthmore, Bowdoin, etc.)
- 2) ED Round of selective non-Ivy colleges and universities (i.e. Duke, Wash U, Vanderbilt, Emory, etc.)
- 3) Top International Universities (first Oxford admit ever was two years ago, and we only average 1-3 applications per year)


